**Being Faithful in Service**

Verses: Matt. 25:20-24; Zech. 4:10; John 6:5-13.

**Matt. 25:20** And he who had received the five talents came and brought another five talents, saying, Master, you delivered to me five talents; behold, I have gained another five talents.

**Matt. 25:21** His master said to him, Well [done,] good and faithful slave. You were faithful over a few things; I will set you over many things. Enter into the joy of your master.

**Matt. 25:22** And he [who had received] the two talents also came and said, Master, you delivered to me two talents; behold, I have gained another two talents.

**Matt. 25:23** His master said to him, Well [done,] good and faithful slave. You were faithful over a few things; I will set you over many things. Enter into the joy of your master.

**Matt. 25:24** Then he who had received the one talent also came and said, Master, I knew about you, that you are a hard man, reaping where you did not sow, and gathering where you did not winnow.

**Zech. 4:10** For who has despised the day of small things? For these seven rejoice when they see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel; they are the eyes of Jehovah running to and fro on the whole earth.

**John 6:5** Jesus then lifting up His eyes and seeing that a great crowd was coming toward Him, said to Philip, Where shall we buy bread that these may eat?

**John 6:6** But this He said to test him, for He Himself knew what He was about to do.

**John 6:7** Philip answered Him, Two hundred denarii worth of bread is not sufficient for them, that each one may take a little.

**John 6:8** One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said to Him,

**John 6:9** There is a little boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what are these for so many?

**John 6:10** Jesus said, Have the people recline. Now there was much grass in the place. So the men reclined, in number about five thousand.

**John 6:11** Jesus then took the loaves, and when He had given thanks, He distributed to those who were reclining; likewise also of the fish, as much as they wanted.

**John 6:12** And when they were filled, He said to His disciples, Gather the broken pieces left over that nothing may be lost.

**John 6:13** So they gathered [them] and filled twelve handbaskets with broken pieces from the five barley loaves which were left over among those who had eaten.
